"23rd Anniversary of Khojaly Genocide"

Seminar held at Preston Islamabad



Eminent personalities speak about the 'Khojaly Genocide' with a sense of utmost grief and indignation. Term the Genocide that took place 23 years ago as a dastardly act of brutality committed by the Armenian forces on hundreds of innocent Azeri civilians (men, women and children).

Preston University, Islamabad and the Embassy of Azerbaijan jointly organized a seminar on "Khojaly Genocide: The Crime Against Humanity". The seminar was organized to mark the 23rd anniversary of the unparalleled brutal human tragedy that struck Khojaly on February 26, 1992. In this vicious tragedy hundreds of innocent Azeri civilians, including men, women and children, were mercilessly killed by the ruthless





Armenian forces backed by the forces of Soviet Union. The Ambassador of the Republic of Azerbaijan in Pakistan, H.E. Dashgin Shikarov graced the occasion as Chief Guest.

Addressing the distinguished gathering on the occasion, the Ambassador of Azerbaijan, H.E. Dashgin Shikarov briefly unfolded the history of the tragic event. He said that during the fall of USSR, at the turn of the century, the Armenian nationalists raised territorial claims to Azerbaijan demanding Nagorno-Karabakh as an autonomous region. He further said, in 1998 more than 300 thousand Azerbaijanis were expelled from their homelands in Armenia.

The new program, they said, focuses on reconstruction, rehabilitation and peace-building with special focus on education and the socio-economic uplift of the north-western border areas. Parallel to its support for social cohesion, development and democratic institutions in Pakistan, Denmark is working to strengthen its relationship based on mutual trust, mutual respect and mutual benefit. Preston University Represented at 'World Conf. on


The First 'World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction' was held in January 2005 in Kobe, Hyogo, Japan, and adopted Hyogo Framework for Action 2005-2015 (HFA-I); with main theme; "Building the Resilience of Nations and Communities to Disasters". Professor Dr. Baloch Allah Wadhayo, Executive

Director Disaster Research Institute (DRI) Preston University Islamabad, Pakistan represented DRI at "WCDRR-2015". Preston University, in fact, was the only academic institution, both from public as well as private sector, from Pakistan to have participated in the referenced high profile conference. Five priorities were set. Simultaneously International community felt to re-set priorities, and third World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction (WCDRR-2015) was held in Sendai, Japan (March 14-18, 2015) to give final shape to HFA-II, which had taken place after deliberations among the affected countries, stake holders, UNISDR experience, to have improved version of (HFA-I). Consequently (HFA-II) was intensely discussed, deliberated, wherein thousands of participants from all over the world participated in the conference.

Earlier, during the conference in Sendai and at the 6th Asian Ministerial Conference, on 'Disaster Risk Reduction' held in Bangkok, Thailand from June 22-26, 2014, Prof Dr. Baloch vigorously stressed to make education in Disaster Management as one of the most important components of HFA-II. He recommended on the occasion that the heads and other employees of Disaster Management Organizations should be professionally qualified people from duly recognized and chartered public and private universities. His recommendation was given due place in the HFA-II final Sendai Declaration. Participation of Dr. Baloch in the Bangkok and Sendai Conference has boosted the image of Pakistan. It also reflected the strong resolve of Preston University, Pakistan to have a repertoire of educated and trained human capital in the field of Disaster Risk Reduction and Management.



Seminar on "23rd Anniversary of Khojaly Genocide"

Many of them were killed. Soon after the disintegration of the USSR, the Armenian Armed Forces launched an open aggression against the newly born Azerbaijan Republic. During the years 1992-1993 twenty per cent of Azerbaijan's territory that included Nagorno-Karabakh and seven adjacent districts were occupied. The war, he said, led to deaths and wounding of thousands, and hundreds of thousands either became refugees or were forcibly displaced. Several thousand disappeared







without trace. Ambassador Shikarov emphatically stated that there could be no long-term peace without justice and respect for human dignity, rights and freedom. He expressed his government's profound gratitude to the government of Pakistan and all the other countries who have adopted resolutions condemning the atrocities committed on innocent civilians by the Armenian forces in Khojaly.

Eminent among the other speakers who shed light on the subject were Prof. Dr. Manzoor Ahmed Afridi, Head of Department of International Relations, International Islamic University, Islamabad, Prof. Dr. Sohail Mahmood, Head of Department of International Relations, Preston University, and Mr. Atiq-ur-Rehman, Senior Instructor, Department of International Relations, NUML, Islamabad. In their brief discourse on the Khojaly Massacre, the speakers said that human history is replete with shocking and heartrending acts of brutality of inconceivable magnitude, committed by one group against the other, one country against another. They maintained that the Khojaly Genocide which was committed by the ruthless and cold-blooded Armenian forces, backed by the equally merciless Soviet forces, in February 1992, is yet another tragic and shocking episode of genocide that has no parallel in history.

PINSAT NCNST, Delegation Beijing, Visits China

A two-member delegation from Preston Institute of Nano Science and Technology (PINSAT) Preston University, comprising of Dr. N. M. Butt (Chairman PINSAT) and Dr. K. Yaldram (Professor of Physics) visited the

Prof. Chen Wang (former Director NCNST and Executive Director of Academic Committee), Prof. Yuliang Zhao (Vice Director NCNST) and Heads of various laboratories of NCNST. Presentations on their respective Institutions were made by Prof. Minghua Liu and Prof. Dr. N. M. Butt. The presentations were followed by general discussions on how collaboration between the two institutions could progress further. At the research level it was suggested that closer collaboration between the two institutes was possible in some areas of nanotechnology. Prof. Chen Wang spoke highly of the standard of research in the area of nanotechnology in Pakistan and his desire to see the blossoming of collaboration between the two institutes. The other Chinese professors, during the meeting, expressed their keen desire to have more students from PINSAT to work at their Centre in addition to the four already committed for the year 2015.

- Visit of the delegation was arranged to various laboratories of NCNST including the Nanofabrication laboratory, Nanomeasurement laboratory, Nanobiotechnology laboratory, laboratory of nanocharacterization, laboratory of nanomanufacturing and applications, and the testing laboratory for nanostructures
- The delegation held a meeting with the Pakistani researchers working at NCNST. The researchers made presentations on the work they were doing and discussed matters related to their stay in China
- The delegation visited the School of Science at Jiaotong University. This School has introduced a BS 4 years program on the same lines as the BS program
 of PINSAT. Fruitful discussions were held with Prof. Ding Kejian (Director nanomaterials program) and Prof. FengQibo (Dean of School of Sciences). The two
 sides agreed to further collaborate in sharing their scheme of studies and other resources
- Dr. N. M. Butt visited the Institute of Physics at the University of CAS. During his visit to various laboratories of the Institute, in particular the solid state
 physics laboratory, the Chinese physicists expressed interest in having Pakistani students for their PhD program
